



PRESS RELEASE

Air Crash Victims' Families' Federation International (ACVFFI) established in Spain July 7, 2015 with registration No 608100 and recognized as "observer" by ICAO February, 29, would like to issue the following statement with respect to the air disaster of Flight FZ981 FlyDubai Boeing 737-800, near Rostow Airport, South of Russia on March 19, 2016:

1. Our condolences, support and solidarity with the families of 62 victims. We are here for any help or support they need.
2. We request Dubai and Russian Governments to follow the Doc 9998 Policy on Assistance of Air Accident Victims and their Families. Relevant Authorities should take action to minimize the suffering of affected families.
3. ACVFFI insists ICAO Representatives to provide assistance by taking into account lessons learnt by other previous accidents.
4. Specially, ACVFFI requests to Civil Aviation Authorities of governments of Dubai and Russia to investigate the cause of disaster by following Standards and Recommended Practices of Annex 13 of ICAO. In addition, we hope they will release results of transparent investigation.

ACVFFI unifies commercial aviation victims from everywhere in order to improve the common management of air disaster. At least, we aim to improve victims' and their families' assistance, passenger rights, accident investigation and air safety.
